Eligibility

Any Yuma area student in grades 5-12 for the 2019-2020 school year.

Students may be placed in advanced groups at the camp instructors' discretion

Class Descriptions

1. Beginning Band-For Any student who has never played a band instrument.
2. Intermediate Band-For students who have successfully completed one to two years of band.
3. Concert Band- For students who have had at least one year in the Advanced Band at their home school.
4. Music Theory- Independent computer work at the student's own pace on the rules of writing music. Required for all students who have not taken theory at least twice or completed the program.
5. Second Instrument-For students who already play an instrument and want to try a second one- Band instruments only.
6. Jazz Ensemble-For older, more experienced players. Designed to teach basic jazz fundamentals. **Must have successfully completed 2 years on their instrument.**
7. Percussion Ensemble-For percussion students who have had at least one year of band.
8. Choir – A chance for all students interested in learning about singing and participating in a choir.
10. Beginning Orchestra-For any student has never played a string instrument.
11. Instrument Repair Class- For advanced students only. Students will learn basics of repairing multiple types of instruments. This is a hands-on class where students will work on instruments. **Students must get a recommendation from their instructor. This class will have a cap of 15 students.**

You must make arrangements for instrument check-out with the band director at your child's school. Orchestra instruments will be provided on a first come, first served basis
